Dear Mr. President, Dear Councillors,

The World Transplant Games are an international sporting event that is equally committed to a vital social goal: increasing the willingness to become an organ donor. It would therefore be a great honor for Berlin to host the many people coming from all over the world to take part in this remarkable athletic competition after having overcome catastrophic illness with successful transplants.



Berlin is a renowned sports capital that has served as the stage for many international sports highlights, thanks to its superb competition venues. Some of the most recent examples include the 2009 World Championships in Athletics, with their terrific atmosphere, the 2010 European Beach Volley-ball Championships, and – this year – the Women's Football World Cup and the 2011 European Gymnastics Championships. There are also huge annual events like the ISTAF, the Six-Day Race, and the Berlin Marathon. These and many other smaller events have shown over and over again how much Berliners love sports. Even as spectators, the people of Berlin create a great atmosphere at sporting events of all kinds. I am therefore confident that the athletes competing in the 20th World Transplant Games in 2015 will feel right at home in Germany's capital city.

At the same time, we in Berlin want to support the World Transplant Games Federation's cause and promote organ donation.
